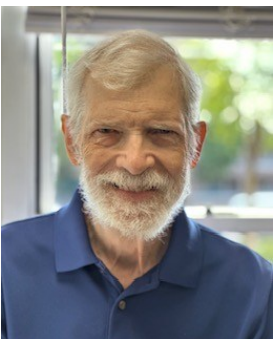

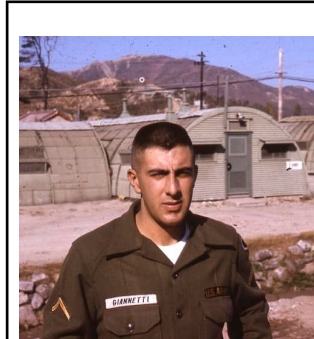
Sculptures and Lunch/Friday, Sept 5/Departs 10:00am

Historical Fiction blends fictional elements with accurate portrayal of historical details, social norms, cultural practices, or a key event. Creative Non-Fiction is a genre that blends *factual* storytelling with literary techniques and evolved from ancient forms like historical accounts and personal essays; stories centered on an historical person, place or event, and early journalism. *[Please note these books have been moved to Non-Fiction shelving].*
