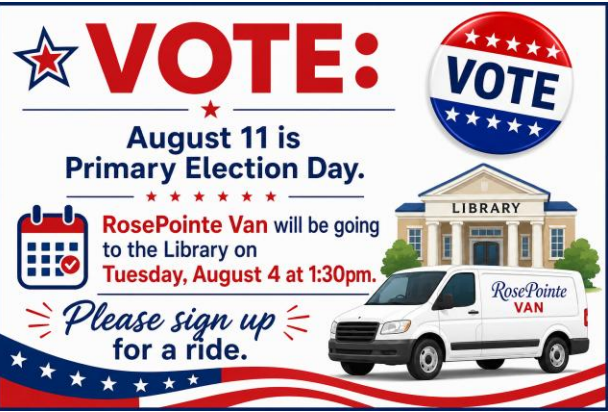
Karla’s Lake Home/Saturday, August 8/Departs 9:30am
